GLASSHOUSE



Located on the ground floor of the William Morris Gallery, with sunlit views overlooking Lloyd Park, our Glasshouse with veranda, offers both indoor and outdoor seating. A perfect venue for your guests and reception.

We can organise and cater for standing receptions or private dinners. Available as an evening venue throughout the week and for full-day hire on Mondays, when it can be used as an additional space for weddings or ceremonies.

THE LANDING



Guests arrive into The Landing via the Gallery's original sweeping staircase; a perfect location for photography. The space can be organised for both seated and standing events.

A light, airy, and extremely flexible space on the first floor of the Gallery with original Georgian features.

If booking a ceremony on a Monday, this space can be booked with the Glasshouse for your reception.

ACANTHUS



Located on the top floor of the Gallery in what was originally the servants' quarters of the house, this room is filled with Georgian character and architectural features, including its beautiful bay window and panelled walls.

This room is available throughout the week. If booking on a Monday (or in the evening), it can be booked with the Glasshouse for a ceremony and then reception.

FAQs

What is William Morris Gallery ?

William Morris Gallery is the only public gallery devoted to the designer and craftsman William Morris. Housed in the Grade II* listed building that was once Morris' family home, the Gallery displays the world's largest collection of his work, alongside contemporary exhibitions and an active events and learning programme.

How do I make an enquiry about a booking?

Is the building accessible?

Yes. The entrance, bathroom, shop, cafe and exhibition spaces are accessible by wheelchair, with lift access to the first and second floors. Additional services for visitors with disabilities include an induction loop and a BSL tour of the Gallery. Read more about access [HERE](#).

Is the building open to the public?

Yes the Gallery is open to the public Tuesday to Sunday 10am – 5pm. As the Gallery is closed on a Monday, this allows for more flexibility around venue hire bookings.

Is there parking on-site?

Parking can be made available for wedding cars and for event attendees with blue badges. There is also a parking bay across the road from the Gallery for coaches. The streets around the park are controlled parking zones; only blue badge holders can park in CPZs. There is a pay-and-display car park next to the Forest Road entrance, (accessed from Bedford Road).

Does the venue have security?

Duty Managers are responsible for general event security. Additional security is required for evening events (from 6pm to 11pm).

What is the maximum capacity of the venue?

Our maximum capacity across the venue for events is 150 people.

Is there any outside space with the venue?

Our Glasshouse has a veranda space that can be enjoyed by guests. You can also take a walk in the surrounding gardens of Lloyd Park.

How do I book a site visit?

Get in touch with the team today about your event and they will arrange a tour of the venue for you.

Can I decorate or brand the space for my event?

You can bring your own signage and decorations for our spaces but details will need to be approved via our operations team. No glitter or party poppers are allowed in the building.

Can I bring in my own caterers?

We ask that all events use our recommended caterers list. Red wine can only be served in the Glasshouse. White wine and champagne can be served in all the hire spaces.

FAQs

Can I use third party suppliers?

For other services such as floristry or photography, we are happy for you to use a third party supplier. Our venue hire team can also provide advice and recommendations where necessary.

Can I arrange a tour for my guests?

Yes. Engage your guests with a tour of the building with one of our Curators. These can be as in-depth as you like and tailored to your occasion.

Can I hire the whole building?

Yes. We offer exclusive venue hire during the evening and on Mondays, when the Gallery is closed to the public.

How late can I book the venue?

11pm is our normal finishing time for events however we are able to extend this to midnight if required.

Do you offer a charity discount?

We offer a 10% charity discount on room hire for registered UK charities.
